

**Executive Summary of the Admissions Criteria Consultation for
St. John Paul II Multi-Academy for 2020-21.**

1. Please refer to the websites of the individual schools in the multi-academy to see actual admissions criteria for each school.
2. Please note that all schools in the St. John Paul II Multi-Academy have been greatly oversubscribed for many years. Therefore, parents are strongly advised to obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice in order to maximise the chances of their child obtaining a place. Please see Note 3 in each school's document for further explanation. Even more information can be found by looking at the guidance for clergy when filling in the certificate. The parent/carer of the applicant should contact the priest you will be asking to sign the form and ask them how they will interpret the guidance. The guidance can be found on this link.

3. The order for admission in any criteria that is oversubscribed in any schools of the St. John Paul II Multi-Academy are;
 - i) Those applicants with a sibling
 - ii) Those applicants with a Catholic Certificate of Practice
 - iii) Those applicants who live closest to where the distance is measured in any of the schools
